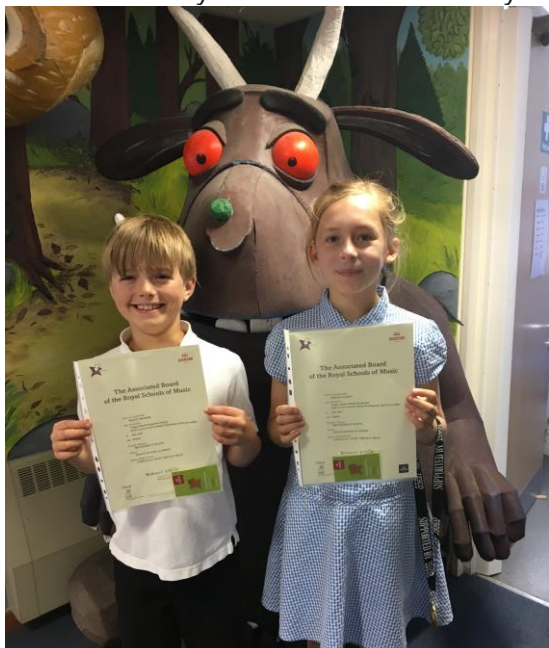


## CELEBRATION WEEK
