Please do not bring in any donations until after the February half-term break, as we simply don't have capacity to store the bags at school. Many thanks in advance.

HEALTHY SNACKS AND DRINKS REMINDER!

All schools have a duty to promote healthy lifestyles, and to educate the children in our care to be healthy, so we only allow fruit or vegetable snacks at playtime, which children can bring in from home. We do not allow children to eat crisps, chocolate, etc at break times. Remember that Mousehole Class and Key Stage One children (Godrevy, Longships and Pendeen) are given a piece of fruit or veg every day for snack, as part of the School Fruit and Veg Scheme. We also encourage the children to stay hydrated, drinking water regularly. All the taps in school are drinking water safe, and we have a couple of water fountains too. Children are welcome to bring in water bottles from home to use in class (not single use plastic please!). Please make sure these are named and only have water in them. Thank you. Some snack suggestions:

Carrots, Celery, sugar snap peas, cucumber, peppers, broccoli, cauliflower, avocados, homemade veggie chips (like sweet potato or kale), apples, bananas, grapes, berries, cherries, peaches, plums, pears, oranges, tangerines, clementines, grapefruit, melon, kiwi, pineapple, mango, raisins, apricots, prunes, dates.
