### **PARLYMPICS EXCELLENCE**


We would like to say a huge congratulations to Melissa Reid, an ex-MHA pupil, who won Bronze in the Triathlon in the Paralympics in Rio last week.

It is Mrs Allen-Blackmore's last day with us on Thursday, before she starts her maternity leave. We would like to take this opportunity to wish her and her family the very best!


## SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR
