Bag2School base their collection around weight and not quality, so please send all of your old clothes. Feel free to use black bags if you have more than one bag full.

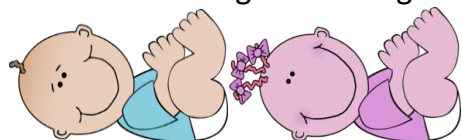
The collection date will be Friday 11th November at 9am. Please feel welcome to bring any bags in from **Wednesday 9th November**.
