ATTENDANCE

It is so important for children to attend school regularly, both for academic and social reasons. We understand that there are times when children are poorly and do seem to go through a run of illnesses. Also, there are 175 days of school holiday a year - nearly half a year! We do understand that there are times when it is impossible to take holidays in holiday time, but these requests can only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. Missing school has a real impact on children's learning and friendships and it can then take them time to settle back into a school

routine. Obviously, 100% attendance is wonderful, but anything at 96% and above gives our children the best chance of success. Our whole school attendance is currently at 97%. We shared your child's attendance record with you during the Parent Consultations. Aspire have also approved a new Attendance Policy which is available on our website under the parents tab.
