Last week, the school team played two League matches, winning both; 10-nil against Threemilestone, and 11-nil against Kea. Also, our B Team won 5-2, against Kea.

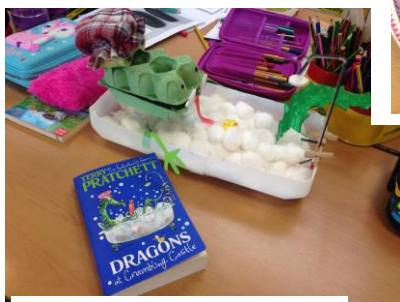
YEAR 5/6 NETBALL
