REWARDS AT MOUNT HAWKE ACADEMY

We have many positive reward systems that work in a consistent way in our school to encourage the children. Each Class gives out Reward Tickets, which the children place in one of the five buckets for our 5 school rules:-

✓ We are ready to learn
✓ We take good care of equipment
✓ We follow directions
✓ We are calm
✓ We respect each other

These are drawn out in our Friday Celebration Assembly, in exchange for a prize. In this assembly each class teacher also awards a 'Celebration' and an 'Achievement' certificate for kindness, team work, effort and hard work.

Once a month (from October), each teacher also chooses a Superstar and these children go to Waterstones on the school minibus, to choose a book as a prize.

We also all send out two 'Praise Postcards' each half-term, letting you know that your child has done something extra special.

All of this runs alongside the 'Well done', or 'You've worked hard' comments that all of the adults in the school use.

We will be holding our annual Scholastic Book Fair in the School Hall, before school, from 8:30am, and after school, from 3pm, from Friday 16th September, until Wednesday 21st September. LUNCHTIME REWARDS

Each Friday three children are chosen by the Lunchtime Supervisor to be the 'Lunchtime Star of the Week'. These role models have their picture taken and put up on display and at the end of the month they can bring in a toy from home (scooter, bike, roller skates, tennis racket), to use in a special area of the playground as a reward. This recognises good playground behaviour, table manners, a helpful attitude and being kind to others.
