On Monday after school, Sustrans, Cornwall Council and St Agnes Parish Council held a meeting here to update the School Streets project. During the closure times, there has been a 40% reduction in car travel through the village, making the journeys to and from school so much safer. Thank you so much for your support with this and for changing travel to school routines. Please remember that the timed road closures are legally enforceable so please do not drive in the closure area between 8:15am and 9:00am, and 2:30pm and 3:45pm.

A plan to add a crossing, widen pavements and improve the streetscape with planters and paving designs was shared, and we are very hopeful that some of these improvements will be started by Cornwall Council over the next year.

# Year Six Moving On – deadline for applications is the end of this month

It is that time of year – if you have a child in Year Six, please make sure that you complete their application for secondary school before 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025. The online application system is open and detailed information about the admissions process is available online at <a href="https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions">www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions</a>.

It is important that you name more than one preference. This will not give you less chance of securing a place at your preferred school. Please also check your eligibility for Home to School Transport before naming your preferences.
