<p>Mathematics We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term, we will be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiplication and division • Statistics • Time • Fractions <p>Science Materials The children will be looking at a variety of materials and investigate their properties.</p>	<p>Art We will be learning about the artist Henri Rousseau. We will explore the skills and techniques used by him and create our own 'Portrait-Landscape' pictures.</p> <p>DT We'll be exploring the different features on vehicles and will learn about wheels, axles and chassis. We will then design and make our own moon buggies.</p>	<p>Music We will follow the Charanga scheme. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, the children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs</p> <p>RE We will be identifying some of the key Muslim beliefs and looking at why Easter is important to Christians.</p>	<p>PE In PE this term we will be developing the skills of dribbling, passing and receiving using our feet. In dance we will be responding to music through movement. We will also be working with others to create and perform movement sequences.</p> <p>PSHE We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe and the value of money and how it is used in the wider world.</p>	<p>English This term we will be focusing on the following objectives: Using capital letters and full stops consistently in sentence. Using adjectives – writing expanded noun sentences. Using commas in a list. Writing sentences in statements, exclamations, questions and commands.</p> <p>Spelling Year 2 will now begin a spelling programme. Each week the children will learn spelling rules from the National Curriculum.</p>

The United Kingdom and The Moon Landings The books we will be reading include Bob and the Moontree Mystery along with stories set in space.				
The children will be writing stories, and poems.				
<p>History The children will be learning about and investigating questions about the moon landing including looking at why the astronauts risk their lives, what they did when they landed on the moon and how we know the moon landings happened.</p> <p>Geography The children will be using maps, atlases and globes to locate the UK. They will learn the names and locations of countries that make up the UK and learn what it is like in each of the countries.</p>	<p>Homework The children's homework is to read everyday and practise the weekly spellings and sounds. Children will also be asked to learn their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p>
