





Welcome to Gwithian Class – Summer Term 2026

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term we will be focussing on:</p> <p>Year 2: Fractions, time, statistics, position and direction.</p> <p>Year 3: Fractions, money, time, shape and statistics.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>We will be completing our unit of work on 'Plants' and then moving on and looking at the role of a scientist and exploring what they actually do and why.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>Our next unit of work in art, will explore chromatic ideas. We will be looking at the ways artists use colour—<i>its hue, intensity, contrast, and emotional impact</i>—to create meaning, mood, and visual interest.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT</u></p> <p>After Half Term, the children will complete a unit of work entitled 'Making Pencil Cases'. They will enjoy designing and creating their own pencil cases.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will follow the Charanga scheme. We will listen to a variety of songs and reflect on what we have heard, thinking about the style of music. This term, we will complete two units of work entitled 'The Dragon Song' and 'Bring Us Together'.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will begin the term looking at ancient stories and how they influence modern celebrations. Then we will be thinking about religion in the local area.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>In PE this term we will be completing units of work on 'Tennis' and 'Striking and Fielding'.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>We will also be preparing for our Sports Day events.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>We will begin by looking at a narrative entitled 'World Robot,' and we will complete some work based around this. We will then look at biographies, thinking about inspirational people.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics/ Spellings</u></p> <p>Year 2: This term we will complete the Little Wandle Spelling Units for Year 2 children.</p> <p>Year 3: We will continue completing fluency reading sessions in school. Year 3's will bring home a Big Cat reading book for you to practise at home.</p>
<p>We will then be completing a unit of work entitled 'Under the Sea.' We will be looking at what a habitat is and investigating which kinds of organisms can live in a marine habitat and why. We will also be exploring the life processes that all organisms have in common.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We will begin by learning about the internet and how to use it safely. These will include the fiction books Harry the Poisonous Centipede and Oliver and the Seawigs. We will also enjoy the non-fiction book How we lived in Ancient Times.</p>			<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Homework</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reading and sharing books every day. - Practising the phonemes/ spelling patterns and tricky words being taught that week. - Practising our times tables for the week. - Completing the maths homework activity for the week. <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Challenge</u></p> <p>Can you complete your homework activities every night?</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>Following on from our popular topics of The Sumer and Indus Valley Civilisation. This term the children will be learning about another early civilisation- The Shang.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will be learning about 'Settlements' and exploring the question 'where do people live and why?'</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>We will be thinking about and holding discussions about 'Being our Best'.
