<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term we will be focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Money</li> <li>- Time</li> <li>- Length &amp; Height</li> <li>- Position &amp; Direction</li> <li>- Mass, Capacity &amp; Temperature</li> </ul> <p><b>Science</b></p> <p>In Science we will be completing work based on Plants and Animals Including Humans. We will be visiting Feadon Farm and learning to answer a range of questions including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can I name the different stages in a human timeline?</li> <li>• Can I explain what happens as a human grows?</li> <li>• Can I describe the basic needs of animals for survival?</li> <li>• Can I describe the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of food?</li> </ul> <p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>We will be looking at 'Grouping Data' and 'Digital Writing'.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>As part of our 'Colour Creations' unit of work we will learn about primary colours, light and dark and different shades. We will complete a study based on Wassily Kandinsky.</p> <p><b>DT</b></p> <p>In DT we will be completing a unit of work called 'Perfect Pizzas'. We will explore a range of bread-based products, explore pizza toppings and design and create our own healthy pizzas.</p> <p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>In Geography we will be exploring the weather and climate of the United Kingdom. We will focus on our seasons and the changes that happen in each season.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>In Music we will be completing the Charanga units 'Zootime' and 'Friendship'.</p> <p><b>RE</b></p> <p>In RE we will be thinking about 'What is the good news Jesus brings?' and 'What makes some places in Cornwall sacred?'</p> <p><b>History</b></p> <p>In History we will be completing a unit of work entitled 'Rescues Then and Now'. We will explore the life of Grace Darling and learn why she is remembered today. We will then look at the RNLI and the work that they do.</p>	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>We will be following our Complete PE Scheme, completing the units 'Locomotion: Jumping Games for Understanding' and then 'Health and Wellbeing'.</p> <p>Pendeen's PE days will be on a Monday and Friday.</p> <p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>In PSHE the children will be thinking about, 'Being my Best' and 'Growing and Changing', making use of the SCARF curriculum.</p>	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>This term we will be focusing on the following objectives: <u>Year 2</u></p> <p>I can use capital letters and full stops consistently in sentences. I can write expanded noun phrases. I can use commas in a list. I can write sentences in statements, exclamations, questions and commands.</p> <p><b>Spelling</b></p> <p>We will follow the Little Wandle 'Spelling' programme each day, learning spelling rules and patterns.</p> <p>We will continue to give the children an opportunity to change their 'Star Books' each day. Children working on the Little Wandle phonics programme will continue to change their 'Spot Books' each Friday.</p>
