

<u>Mathematics</u> We follow a Mastery approach to teaching maths and this term, we will be focussing on: - Place Value - Four operations - Fractions - Position and direction	<u>Art</u> Typography– Children will learn about fonts and layouts and how they help us communicate ideas and emotions. They will explore the artist Grayson Perry. <u>DT</u> British Dishes – Children will investigate national dishes and learn about the influences of, and similarities between cuisines from other countries. <u>French</u> Me and My Friends - <i>Pupils will describe feelings, recap personal information, introduce a friend and discuss school subjects and opinions.</i> This is the city - We will look at a French city, learn how to buy a ticket, give directions, use descriptions and explore shopping.	<u>Music</u> Bon Jovi - We will follow the Charanga scheme. The children will play and compose live music and will discover more about classic rock music and the songs of Bon Jovi. <u>RE</u> What does it mean for Christians to believe that God is holy and loving? – Children will explore Biblical texts and Christian ideas of God. They will consider how Christians put their beliefs into practice. What does it mean to be Muslim in Britain today? – Pupils will explore Muslim beliefs about God, the Prophet, and the Holy Qur'an.	<u>PE</u> Following our Complete PE Scheme, in PE this term, we will be focusing on our Invasion skills in netball and tchoukball, and in Gymnastics we will concentrate on matching and mirroring. We will also look at leadership in Outdoor Adventure Activities. <u>PSHE</u> Me and my relationships – Children will explore emotional needs and feelings, how to be a good friend and being assertive. Valuing differences – children will discuss recognising and celebrating differences, and the influence and pressure of social media.	<u>English</u> Grammarsaurus (The Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar) – Children will be focussing on different areas within grammar, starting with a noun focus and then moving onto verbs and finally subject/verb focus. Pandora – Children will be exploring features of effective non chronological reports and then researching and writing their own. Rain Player – Children will use this book by David Wisniewski to write a newspaper report. <u>Reading</u> Reading and listening to your child read every night makes a big difference to their progress in all areas of learning. Reading for pleasure is something we encourage and we always welcome discussion about books and poetry in class. Please reinforce this love of reading at home with your children and ensure that they bring their reading books to school each day. Along with opportunities to read for pleasure in class, pupils will take part in more formal reading comprehension sessions where we will focus on developing reading skills, such as inference, vocabulary choices and authorial intent. During these sessions, we will explore a variety of fiction, non-fiction texts and poetry.	
<u>Computing</u> Systems and networks – Children will explore the roles of computer systems in our lives. Video Editing – Children will identify devices that can capture video and explore the features of an effective video.
