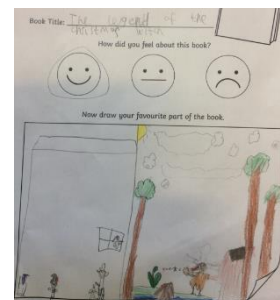

Monitoring Visit

Last Friday, we had our termly Monitoring Visit. Mr Earnshaw, a Director from Aspire, and Mr Horswell, our Hub Councillor, visited for the day and watched lessons and spoke to children and adults. Both visitors were very impressed with the attitudes for learning and behaviour that our children showed throughout the day and the way that our children become confident readers, using Little Wandle for Letters and Sounds as our phonics scheme. They were very pleased to see how much knowledge our children can recall from their learning in history and geography too. Our next steps are to continue to review our curriculum, making links across our learning and to make sure that we hold a reading open morning soon so everyone can share our love of reading.

Defibrillator

We are on a mission to extend our first aid kit and purchase a life-saving device – a defibrillator – and training package to ensure that, should anyone experience a cardiac arrest, we have the equipment and skills to help save a life. There is one in the village, but we feel that having one in school too is very important.
