Dear Families

We are so excited to be welcoming everyone back to school on Monday 8th March. We are busy finalising our plans to make sure that everyone remains as safe as possible. It is likely that things will be organised very much as they were in the Autumn Term, but we will confirm all our arrangements with you during next week. We know that most children will be delighted to be back, but there will also be understandable anxieties over this. We will make sure that we spend time focussing on the whole child, settling back into routines, enjoying developing friendships again and valuing all the wonderful learning experiences that have happened while they have been learning in different ways, as well as continuing with our academic learning. We will, of course and as ever, adjust our teaching in all areas to meet the needs of all our learners to ensure that everyone gets the best possible whole child education.

As one part of this, we will continue to be making use of My Personal Best from the Youth Sports Trust, focussing on new units to plan and explicitly teach life skills and character through PE and other areas of the curriculum. This will support the personal development of all children in and through PE, and also make connections to other lessons, school and wider life. It will help with the transferability of skills, supporting transition back into school, aiding emotional, social, and cognitive recovery. The themes that we are following are:
