We have been in regular contact with Aspire and Public Health England and they have checked our arrangements for minimising the spread of the virus. Thank you to everyone who has taken children for PCR testing either when the child shows symptoms at home or when we have asked children or classes to be tested. Please remember to let us know the results as soon as you receive them, even if they are negative.
