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FOMHS PTA needs your help and new members! Some of the committee have to stand down this year having been in post for 3 years, so we need new joiners. Anyone can join in, help, contribute ideas, or time, please do, every little helps. We used to run coffee mornings to meet new parents and explain what FOMHS does for the school and parents and carers, but this hasn't been possible during Covid, so please do go onto Facebook, find our closed group - FOMHS and request to join us. Everyone is welcome! It's a wonderful feeling to be able to do small things to help and raise funds to provide fun things for the children. In the past year, FOMHS has raised funds and motivated the community to provide an amazing Pumpkin trail, Elf Trail, free Smartie tubes for all children, planters for the playground, plants, flowers, skipping ropes for all classes, new beanbags for class, book storage, transport for swimming lessons, a Mousehole cat play for KS2, an online Pantomime for all the children, top up funds toward air filters, 30 French dictionaries and a trip to Bodmin Jail for year 6.
