With only a couple more weeks until Easter, the children continue to work so hard. Last week we had our termly review from Aspire. Mrs Osborne, who spent time in school looking at lessons, children's work and talking to the children, was delighted to see the progress that continues to be made. She commented, 'Their enthusiasm and engagement is evident' and was impressed with the children's progress in phonics following Little Wandle for Letters and Sounds, their knowledge and recall of information in History and Geography, and the way that our youngest children in EYFS embrace their curriculum. Our next steps include making the children more aware of why they are studying a topic and what is special and distinct about each subject.



Following on from the Sustrans (the walking, wheeling and cycling charity) survey about ways we travel to school, we were delighted to have a visit from Dr Bike today. Dave checked and repaired many bikes and it will be great to have even more children cycling into school.

We are delighted that Gwithian came away with 85 points and Lamorna with 84, both Commended.
