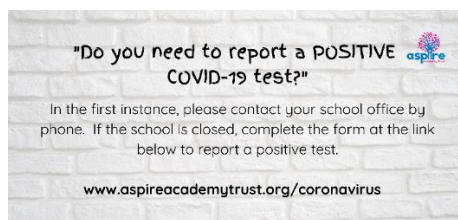
Uniform
